MP – Accommodation is likely to be centered around Parramatta (not CBD) and 2019 delegates can advise the other states there are transport to city option readily available. MP – Aiming for a \$100 per night accommodation cost RM –Ryde Parramatta (Mon) and Strathfield (Tue) penciled in as host courses for the Elliott RM – Suggests that some committee members try the course over the next few months to evaluate the new layout and refurbishments.
