Action items C'Fwd

22/8/23	Electronic scoring	MP	<p>22/8/23 MP to explore options available for electronic scoring eg; MiScore</p> <p>5/10/23 CFwd to 1/2024</p> <p>8/2/24 RudiM gave a rundown of MiScore costing. \$20 pa pp to download app. If you are a member of a club with MiScore it is free. If not, it is a cost of \$19.57 pa pp. We can set up a comp for up to 50 players with live leaderboard, updated by individual players/markers. MiScore does not create tee times and does not do cross checking of scores. 14 day fee trial available and Rudi to test on an upcoming trip. GF advised MiScore is used by Vets but cost included in Vets fees. Vets have 100-120 players per event. Consensus is that there is potential to use MiScore. Cost for club to set up to be explored by MV. GolfPad could still be used for booking etc.</p> <p>18/4/24 No action on this item since last meeting. RudiM advised that MiScore was not used on his recent golf trip as expected. MV asked whether it is appropriate to poll membership re use of MiScore including potential subsidy of member costs. General consensus no need. Further general discussion held on use of MiScore.</p> <p>RudiiM questioned whether there was a seamless link between MiScore and GolfLink.</p>

GF confirmed his understanding that the events are set up in MiScore which picks up GolfLink handicap and at the end of the event info is fed back into GolfLink. He also understands that it does the clac including countbacks etc.

GF to find out more detail on how it is used in the Veterans events.

CFwd to next meeting.

13/6/24

- GF still to investigate details of Veterans use of MiScore.
- MP advises super easy to use and considers it worthwhile.
- At some point we will need to consider whether club will subsidise cost.
- MP suggested cost \$19 pp be added to club membership.
- WF also pointed out efficiency of MiScore scoring at club games.

22/8/24

GF advised:

- New MiScore app being trialed and will be available late 24 aimed more at social clubs with more beneficial costs.
- Vets tied up with Westpac though Nth Sydney Leagues Club and it may be possible for us to piggy back of their arrangement.
- Suggested we wait until new app is introduced then look at it further.

GE asked whether a merger with another club should be investigated in the future given gradual decline in CBA numbers. General agreement that it is something we can consider going forward. SC suggested that it could be a possible discussion point at AGM.

CFwd to next meeting

2/10/24

- General agreement that MiScore is the way to proceed but with new MiScore app being trialed, costs and the possibility/benefits of joining with other groups etc are not yet able to be gauged.

So I checked MiScore and found a link to PRIVATE COMPETITIONS

- *Up to 50 players (may be able to be used for Bank Holiday - bigger group sizes is coming??)*

Just a few notes:

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Private Competition cannot be sent for handicap to Golf Australia within MiScore App • MiScore App User Subscription is required for players scoring away from their home club. • Private Competition played in-conjunction with a club competition have no relevancy to prize allocations in club competitions • Private Competition doesn't manage player handicaps • Anyone can create a Private Competition and there can be as little as two players as many as 50 players. <p>MiScore website didn't outline how to set up or costs so have sent an online enquiry for more information.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">- GF is waiting on costs of MiScore for each of the various 3 options.</p> <p>CFwd to next meeting.</p> <p>10/4/25 GF still to follow up costings, options and full details of new MiScore system and will do so asap. SC advised that Jeff Cashman has advised that he is happy continuing with current Golfpad system. CFwd to next meeting.</p> <p>12/6/25 GF recommendation that this matter be cfwd until MiScore have finalized changes to their systems. RM has looked at an alternative app that does not sufficiently cater for our club needs. CFwd to next meeting.</p> <p>21/8/225 CFwd to 2025 AGM given Golf Australia changes to come in from 2/10/25. Refer Golf Australia correspondence below.</p> <p>9/10/25 Issues still being resolved in relation to Golf Australia new system. RM continuing to monitor position. Resolved to CFwd to 2025 AGM at which time matter will be further addressed.</p> <p>5/2/26 RM confirmed that there were still problems with Golf Australia system with many bugs still to be resolved. Manual recording will continue in the hope that system issues get resolved in the short term and hopefully before the Bank Holiday event. Invitation Email – RM

- GF to forward current member email list to RM so add details to last years master list held by RM.
- RM to issue email week commencing 15/06.
- MP to update 2025 invitation and forward draft to RM. Update to include the following:
 - Cost of the day to remain at \$110 (golf, cart, trophies, breakfast and lunch).
 - Gateway sponsorship at including provision of a ProV1 golf ball to every player. (*156 branded balls held.*)
 - Veteran entry open to 55yrs+ (*no change*)
 - No Veteran DnP, two DnP holes open to all players.
 - Closing date for entries 24/7/26.

Trophies – SC & MP

- Due to event cancelled in 2025, prizes were carried forward to 2026.
- SC holds perpetual Veteran's (Ted Geckie) trophy and will follow up with winner of Watson-Mason winner (2024) to ensure trophy is present for the game.
- Gateway Trophy has been purchased and engraved for 2026 event.

Raffle

- Prizes are held by SC.
- SC to prepare prize list and table flyer.
- SC has raffle books.
- SC to envelope free purchased raffle tickets and hand them to starters for player registration.
- GE to place additional raffle books, prize list and cash envelopes on each table prior to lunch and collect prior to trophy presentation.
- GE to prepare tickets for draw.

Draw

- RM to prepare draw and issue to players.

Golf Cards
